CITY AND TOWN COUNCIL

Must reside within the City Limits for 1 year and are elected by voters in the City only. City; City of College Place: Non-charter code city under the mayor-council plan of government (RCW 35A-12); Waitsburg: Mayor-council form of Gov't--Territorial Charter Follows all state laws except for Elections-- City Conducts own elections. Prescott: 4th class municipality.

TOUCHET, WALLULA AND SUN HARBOR AND BURBANK #4 WATER DISTRICTS

Must reside in the water district and are elected by voters in the water district.

WALLA WALLA CEMETERY DISTRICT

Must reside in the Cemetery District and are elected by voters in the Cemetery District only.

FIRE DISTRICTS

Must reside in the Fire District and are elected by voters in the Fire District only.

SCHOOL DISTRICTS

Dixie #101, Walla Walla #140 and Touchet #300 may reside anywhere in the School District and are elected by the voters within their District. College Place #250, Columbia #400, Waitsburg #401-100 and Prescott #402-37, must reside in the Director District that they are filing for, but they are elected by voters within the School District. Waitsburg #401-100 and Prescott #402-37 are also in Columbia County.

WAITSBURG PARK & RECREATION DISTRICT

Same boundaries as Waitsburg School District 401-100 and Fire District 2 (in Dixie Precinct). They may reside anywhere in the district and are elected by voters in the District. Park District in Walla Walla County only.

WALLA WALLA COUNTY CONSERVATION DISTRICT

Must be a resident and elector therein. Boundaries are the County of Walla Walla, Washington, excluding all incorporated cities and towns. Conservation Districts must request a "special election" in the even year prior to filing week to run the election in conjunction with the fall primary and general election.

If two or less are running for the same office they run in the General Election only.

If more than two are running for the same office they'll run in the Primary Election. The two highest will then run in the General Election. EVERYONE FILING MUST BE A REGISTERED VOTER.

RCW 29A.20.040 LOCAL ELECTED OFFICIALS, COMMENCEMENT OF TERM OF OFFICE--

PURPOSE, 1979 ex.s. c126. (1) The legislature finds that certain laws are in conflict governing the election of various local officials. The purpose of this legislation is to provide a common date for the assumption of office for all the elected officials of counties, cities, towns, and special purpose districts other than school districts where the ownership of property is not a prerequisite of voting. It is also the purpose of this section to remove these conflicts and delete old statutory language concerning such elections which is no longer necessary.

2. For elective offices of counties, cities, towns, and special purpose districts other than school districts where the ownership of property is not a prerequisite of voting, the term of incumbents shall end and the term of successors begins after the successor is elected and qualified, and the term commences immediately after December 31st following the election, except as follows:

a. Where the terms of office varies from this standard according to statute; and
b. If the election results have not been certified prior to January 1st after the election, in which event the time of commencement for the new term occurs when the successor becomes qualified in accordance with RCW 29A.04.133.

3. For elective offices governed by this section, the oath of office must be taken as the last step of qualification as defined in RCW 29A.04.133 but may be taken either:

a. Up to ten days prior to the scheduled date of assuming office; or
b. At the last regular meeting of the governing body of the applicable county, city, town, or special district held before the winner is to assume office.

RCW 29A.24.020 DESIGNATION OF SHORT TERMS, FULL TERMS, AND UNEXPIRED TERMS--
FILING DECLARATIONS--ELECTION TO BOTH SHORT & FULL TERMS.

If at the same election there are short terms or full terms & unexpired terms of office to filled, the filing officer shall distinguish them and designate the short term, the full term, and the unexpired term, as such, or by use of the words "short term," "unexpired two year term," or "four year term," as the case may be.

In filing the declaration of candidacy in such cases, the candidate shall specify that the candidacy is for the short term, the full term, or the unexpired term. When both a short term and a full term for the same position are scheduled to be voted upon, or when a short term is created after the close of the filing period, a single declaration of candidacy accompanied by a single filing fee shall be construed as a filing for both the short term and the full term and the name of such candidate shall appear upon the ballot for the position sought with the designation "short term and full term." The candidate elected to both such terms shall be sworn into and assume office for the term as soon as the election returns have been certified and shall again be sworn into office on the second Monday in January following the election to assume office for the full term.
