

# Walla Walla County HIVA - HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

## Hazard Overview

Hazardous materials include chemicals used in manufacturing, household chemicals, crude oil and petroleum products, pesticides, herbicides, fertilizers, paints, medical wastes, radioactive materials and numerous other substances. Their manufacture, transport, storage, use and disposal place the public, property and environment at risk from their inadvertent or intentional release.

Human error is the greatest contributing factor to hazardous material incidents. The majority of these injury incidents occur on highways, and the resulting fatalities are often passenger car occupants. These incidents primarily involve passenger vehicles and motor carriers hauling flammable liquids such as gasoline.<sup>1</sup>

## History and Probability of Occurrence

Nationwide, there are at least 300 million hazardous materials shipments annually, involving approximately 3.2 billion tons of hazardous materials, and the total tons of hazardous materials produced are predicted to grow by two percent per year.<sup>2</sup>

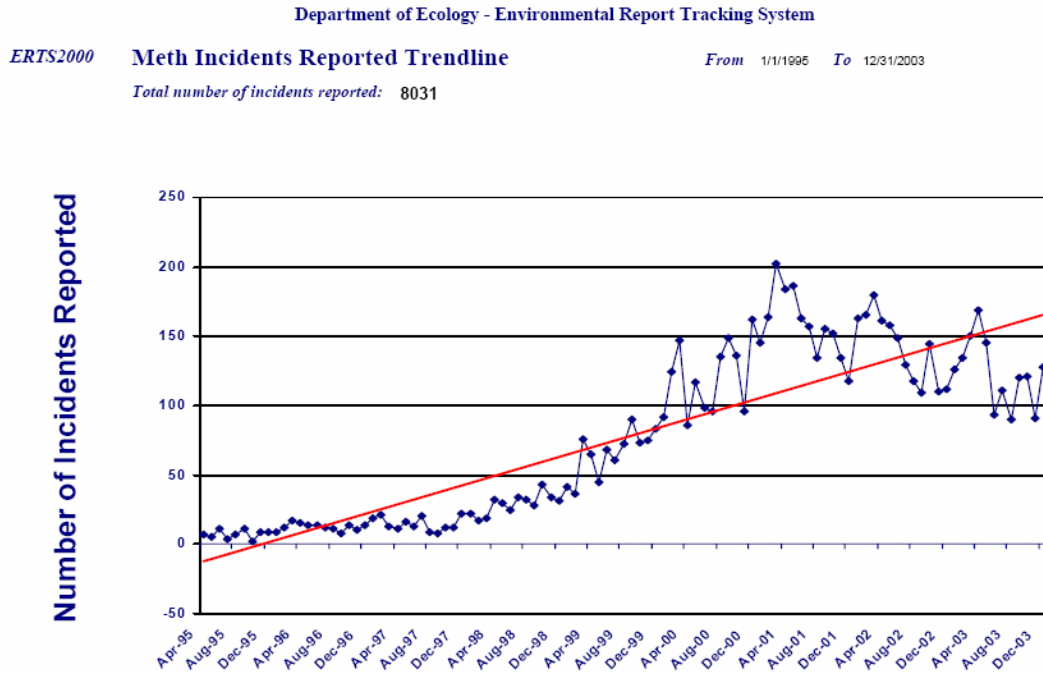

The continuing increase in responses to clandestine methamphetamine labs is of particular concern. The Department of Ecology conducted 1339 drug lab responses in 2004<sup>5</sup>.

Despite a relatively good safety record considering the amounts of hazardous materials through Walla Walla County, there remains potential for incidents in which multiple fatalities, serious injuries, or other costs to the community and businesses could result. See Appendix A for a listing of reported hazardous material incidences from 1999 to 2005.

Walla Walla County is at risk for a variety of hazardous materials incidents. The majority of serious life-threatening hazardous material incidents in this area are related to Anhydrous Ammonia. Walla Walla County is largely a farming community with large amounts of Anhydrous Ammonia used for fertilizer. One incident involving Anhydrous Ammonia, which happened in May of 1996, consisted of a leak in a hose of a truck near the Walla Walla Regional Airport and Highway 12. The tank had been full of ammonia and was almost empty by the time the Hazmat team could stop it. Several businesses were evacuated, roads were blocked and flights were delayed. The wind continued to change, making the release even harder to fight. No injuries were reported, just headaches and slight respiratory problems from residents in the wake of the plume. There has

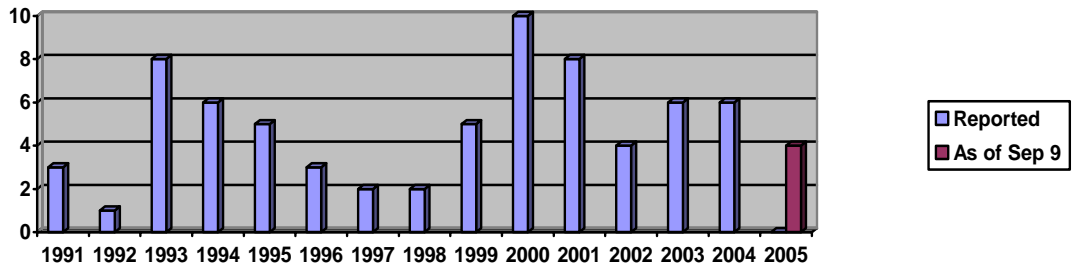

been a past record of hazardous materials incidents that range from minor automobile accidents to fixed facility and transportation incidents.

Data collected on hazardous material incidents cannot be exact. There are multiple reasons for this, the most significant of which is the fact that many hazardous materials incidents go unreported. A second factor is the number of response agencies with alternate methods of incident reporting and record keeping. This may produce two or more records or accounts of the same incident. Even though the information about hazardous materials incidents is somewhat incomplete, it clearly shows that Walla Walla County does have a large number of incidents ranging from very minor auto accident clean up to potentially catastrophic fixed facility or transportation incidents.

There is great likelihood that an event involving one or more hazardous materials will occur in the next 25 years, so a rating of HIGH PROBABILITY is assigned.

### Potential Impact and Vulnerability

Walla Walla County has an active Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC). This LEPC, in concert with Walla Walla County Emergency Management Department, conducts hazard identification, vulnerability analysis, and risk assessment activities for the jurisdictions. Federal and state statutes require the LEPC to maintain reportable hazardous material reports (see Appendix B for a list of companies and their location) and emergency response plans based on the volumes and types of substances found in, or transported through, their districts. Through partnerships with businesses, agencies and responders, the LEPC works to reduce the hazardous material incidences in the county.

An incident involving hazardous materials can occur anytime and any place. The largest storage tank of Anhydrous Ammonia sits in a largely populated area of Walla Walla. There is probable cause for concern because trucks unload from there into above ground and under ground storage tanks during the growing season. In a recent survey of those businesses in Walla Walla County who

deliver or receive shipments of hazardous materials, Anhydrous Ammonia and Diesel Gas were the most used and reported. However, out of the fifty-two businesses included in a local hazardous material transportation flow survey, only twenty-six responded, resulting in incomplete data that may not be representative of Walla Walla County as a whole.

The potential impact of a hazardous material incident depends on the nature of the material, conditions of the release, weather at the time of release, and area involved. Releases may be small, easily handled and with negligible impact, or catastrophic, with immediate impact and long-term public health, habitability and environmental consequences.

Roughly eleven aircraft companies transport hazardous materials to, from or within Walla Walla County. They primarily carry pesticides, herbicides and insecticides. Four railroad companies carry a variety of hazardous materials within Walla Walla County. Wallula Junction is one of the main centers for this mode of transportation. Anhydrous Ammonia and Chlorine are the two primary hazardous materials transported by barges in Walla Walla County. Boise Cascade is the recipient of some of the largest shipments of these materials. Trucking companies provide the bulk of hazardous material transport to, from and within Walla Walla County. Nine of these companies are fleets that are operated by Hazmat businesses, and there are at least twenty-seven common carriers. These carriers transport chiefly along highway 12, highway 730, highway 124 and highway 125. Heavily used streets within the Walla Walla area include College Avenue in College Place, Myra Road, Poplar Street, Alder Street, Tausick Way, Airport Road, Isaacs, 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, Rose Street and Wallula Road. Most incidents occur between one and two o'clock a.m. and four to five p.m.<sup>7</sup> There are many carriers that transport through Walla Walla County that are not reported because they originate in other states such as Oregon, Idaho, California, and even as far away as Minnesota. In short, we don't accurately know what, when and how hazardous materials are being transported in Walla Walla County.

According to the Hazardous Substances Emergency Events Surveillance (HSEES) program there were three police officers injured in Walla Walla County during two hazardous material incidents between the years of 1995 and 2000. By comparing these numbers to those of Washington's other counties, HSEES found that Walla Walla County was one of five counties to have a noticeably greater than average likelihood of officers becoming injured during an HSEES event. Additionally, April and May proved to have a greater proportion of police officer injuries in hazardous material related incidents than any other month. Weekends were notably safer, while Mondays were the most dangerous, and most incidents occurred between the hours of one and two o'clock a.m., and four and five o'clock p.m.<sup>8</sup>

Walla Walla County's vulnerability to a hazardous materials incident increases further due to the types of chemicals that are being transported throughout the county as well. Figure five shows the major chemicals transported throughout Walla Walla County, states whether or not the chemical is extremely hazardous, and shows whether there is a special hazard location in Walla Walla for that chemical.

Walla Walla County is also home to a sizeable amount of hospitals, nursing homes, and jails or prisons. These facilities are especially vulnerable because of their high concentration of people and the increased susceptibility of the young, the elderly, incarcerated and the infirm. They are also extremely difficult to evacuate. Schools have a concentration of younger students who may be easily frightened or confused, causing problems with evacuation. Jails and the prison

have the added problem of security and public safety if they have to evacuate prisoners.<sup>10</sup>

Given the above facts and the relative isolation of Walla Walla and other major cities in the county, Walla Walla County is assigned MEDIUM vulnerability to a hazardous material spill incident. There is great possibility that an important segment of the population, property, commerce, infrastructure or service would be exposed to the effects of a hazardous materials incident.

### **Risk Rating**

A Hazardous Materials incident could potentially have very significant and far-reaching effects on the county. These include the human casualties that may occur at the time of the release, long term or chronic health problems, and significant short term and long-term financial impacts.

History, plus the transport of hazardous materials into and through the county, suggests a high probability of occurrence. A hazardous material spill generally impacts a relatively small area, but if that area is a high-density urban area or a critical wildlife habitat the impact could be significant<sup>11</sup>, suggesting moderate vulnerability. Because of the magnitude of the potential risk posed by the transport of hazardous materials, a MEDIUM risk rating is assigned.
