Brief Duties and Responsibilities: This position will lead, plan, develop, implement and evaluate the WA Department of Health (DOH) Youth Marijuana Prevention Education Program (YMPEP) for nine (9) counties of the Greater Columbia Accountable Communities of Health (GCACH). Work includes implementation of the Tobacco Program for Walla Walla County in collaboration with Benton-Franklin County. Work may involve writing grant applications or major program proposals; requires considerable community needs assessment and consistent evaluations of program effectiveness addressing a wide range of audiences

Working Conditions: Work will be performed both inside and outside of the department in the community at large, such as schools and community groups, in a variety of environments and settings. Requires ability to drive an automobile, fly in a plane, and travel as required. Ability to lift up to 25 to 30 pounds. Requires sufficient hearing and speech ability to communicate verbally. Requires manual dexterity and visual acuity to operate personal computer and peripherals.

Minimum Qualifications: A Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with major course work in health education, health promotion education, or a closely related field is required. A Master's of Public Health degree and two (2) years' experience in Public Health is highly desirable. Prior experience working with youth is preferred. This individual MUST not use tobacco in any form, smoke "electronic cigarettes" or use recreational marijuana.
