NOTE: If the child is enrolled in Early Intervention Services (Birth to Three) and has an IFSP then that child automatically qualifies for DDA - to apply either a developmental screening showing a 1.5 standard deviation, or a 25% delay needs to be submitted with the application **OR** the Early Intervention Services program submits a form (specific form that each ESIT should have) **with the application** stating that the child is enrolled and has an IFSP. For children over three years old, eligibility is based on medical diagnosis and/or assessments.
