**Brief Duties and Responsibilities:** **PWTII:** This is an intermediate position responsible for a variety of duties performed under supervision. This position requires the ability to work independently at times with general supervision and a working knowledge of road or bridge design, construction inspection, surveying, right of way, geographic information systems, or related tasks. **PWTIII:** This is an advanced civil engineering technology position that performs a variety of duties. This position requires substantial knowledge in three or more areas of the essential functions as listed in the job description and the ability to execute those functions with general or limited supervision.
